Professor Elias Karakitsos is chairman of Global Economic Research; Non-Executive Director, General Council, Hellenic Financial Stability Fund (HFSF); and an Associate Member of the Centre for Economic and Public Policy, Department of Land Economy, University of Cambridge. He was a Professor at Imperial College, where he served for nearly 25-years, Head of Economics for 10-years and has acted as an Advisor to governments, including the UK, the US and DGII of the EC, gave Evidence to the House of Commons and acted as Investment Adviser to many financial institutions, including Citigroup, Oppenheimer, Allianz, Credit Agricole and Standard Chartered. He is the author of six books/monographs, more than 100 papers in learned journals and more than 500 reports on the world economy and financial markets.
